The processing of the Conditions of Approval noted in the Resolution of Approval took longer than anticipated, particularly in connection with satisfying the Conditions of Approval that involved satisfying NYCDEP requirements. While NYCDEP was responsive and cooperative, delays were encountered in satisfying their requirements because DEP staff was not always available, given the DEP office was partially closed down during the mandated Covid-19 pandemic restrictions.
