RPRC DETERMINATION LETTER

Project Description: Addition & legalization of patio

Street Location: 45 ROUND HOUSE RD

The above referenced application was reviewed by the Residential Project Review Committee (RPRC).

The Committee determined that Planning Board and Architectural Review Board approval of the proposed project is NOT REQUIRED.

However, the following issues will need to be addressed prior to the issuance of a building permit:

- The applicant shall perform deep and percolation soil testing in the vicinity of the proposed mitigation system to be witnessed by the Town Engineer. The test locations and results shall be shown on the plan. Contact the Town Engineer to schedule the testing.
- Provide rims, inverts, size and material for all drainage facilities. Please provide drainage at the stone terrace.
- Provide a detail for the Sediment Box.
- The plan shall illustrate the location of the existing utilities (well, septic, etc.). Demonstrate that the minimum required WCHD setbacks to the infiltration system/ domestic well/proposed improvements are met.
- The stone terrace is located on the top of the existing septic leaching fields. WCHD Approval is required.
- It appears that disturbances are proposed within the locally-regulated 100-foot wetland buffer. A local administrative Wetland Permit may be required. The applicant shall illustrate the local wetland boundary and regulated 100-foot buffer on the plan for verification by the Town Wetland Consultant. Notify the Town Engineer once the wetland boundary has been established in the field so that a determination regarding the need for a Wetland Permit can be made.

At this time, you must submit two hard copies of revised plans addressing the above issues, this determination letter and a completed building permit application directly to the North Castle Building Department. DO NOT START CONSTRUCTION WITHOUT A VALID BUILDING DEPARTMENT PERMIT.

If blasting or rock chipping is proposed, a permit pursuant to Chapter 122 is required.
