RPRC DETERMINATION LETTER

The above referenced application was reviewed by the Residential Project Review Committee (RPRC).

The Committee determined that Planning Board and Architectural Review Board approval of the proposed project is NOT REQUIRED.

However, the following issues will need to be addressed prior to the issuance of a building permit:

- The proposed new deck does not meet the minimum required rear yard setback of 30 feet. The Applicant will need to secure a variance from the Zoning Board of Appeals.
- Based upon the submitted gross floor area worksheet 6,353 s.f. of gross land coverage is proposed (not 6,377 s.f.). The maximum permitted amount of land coverage is 5,650 s.f.. The Applicant will need to obtain a 703 s.f. GLC variance from the Zoning Board of Appeals.
- The Applicant should submit gross land coverage backup data for review.
- The Applicant should submit a rear elevation of the house with the proposed decks for review.
- The applicant should provide details regarding the proposed foundation for the deck, or explain if existing foundations will be utilized.

At this time, you must submit two hard copies of revised plans addressing the above issues, this determination letter and a completed building permit application directly to the North Castle Building Department. DO NOT START CONSTRUCTION WITHOUT A VALID BUILDING DEPARTMENT PERMIT.

If blasting or rock chipping is proposed, a permit pursuant to Chapter 122 is required.
